

**Minutes of Meeting  
Worley Historical Society/Kootenai Historical Society  
November 26, 2012  
3:00 p.m.**

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman Todd Tondee, Commissioner Dan Green and Commissioner Jai Nelson met to discuss the following agenda items. Also present were Cherilee Albright, Catherine Morris, Dale Keno, Barbara Schultz, John Schultz, Virginia Nigh, Rob Moser, Syd Albright and Deputy Clerk Pamela Bogaert.

**A. Call to Order:** Chairman Tondee called the meeting to order at 3:03 p.m.

**B. Introductions:** There were no introductions made.

**C. Changes to the Agenda:** There were no changes made to the agenda.

**D. Old Business:** There was no old business discussed.

**E. New Business:**

Ms. Catherine Nigh explained to the Board that the Worley Historical Society (Society) is interested in saving the Worley School, built in 1939 under the auspices of the WPA, from demolition. She noted that it was the intention of the Society to convert the school into a museum and cultural center. Ms. Nigh asked that the Board consider declaring the Worley School a historic site and act as a conduit in the transfer of the property from the School District to Kootenai County and, finally, to the Worley Historical Society.

Plummer/Worley Joint School District Superintendent Judi Sharrett has advised the Society's members of the necessary steps required to place the issue before the Board of Trustees, including a written confirmation from the Kootenai County Board of Commissioner acknowledging the status and condition of the building as well as accepting all liability relating to the structure and the land.

The Board agreed that before facilitating the transfer of the property, the Society would need to meet all of the statutory requirements as well as those of the School District. The Board also agreed to forward the issue to the legal department for review.

**F. Staff Reports:** There were no staff reports.

**G. Public Comment:** This section is reserved for citizens wishing to address the Board regarding a County related issue. There was no public comment.

The meeting was adjourned at 3:59 p.m.
