

**Minutes of Meeting
Hayden Lake Watershed Improvement District (HLWID)
No Wake Zone
July 24, 2013
11:00 a.m.**

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman Todd Tondee, Commissioner Dan Green and Commissioner Jai Nelson met to discuss the following agenda items. Also present were Parks and Waterways Director Nick Snyder, Hayden Lake Water Association Inc. (HLWAI) President Geoff Harvey, HLWAI Lake Manager Todd Walker, Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney Pat Braden and Deputy Clerk Brandie Bradley.

- A. Call to Order:** Chairman Tondee called the meeting to order at 11:06 a.m.
- B. Introductions:** There were no introductions made.
- C. Changes to the Agenda:** There were no changes made to the agenda.
- D. Old Business:** There was no old business discussed.
- E. New Business:**
Hayden Lake Water Association Inc. (HLWAI) President Geoff Harvey came before the Board to discuss implementation of a No Wake Zone on Hayden Lake. Mr. Harvey explained to the Board that residents on Hayden Lake have had some concerns with erosion along the waterfronts when the level of the lake is elevated. Generally this is only during the spring months, but can sometimes last longer during years with unusually wet weather. Mr. Harvey asked the Board to put a No Wake Zone in effect during these times of high lake levels. A discussion was held by the Board as to when the No Wake Zone would be appropriate. The Board requested that the HLWAI members work with residents in order to determine at what level they would like the No Wake Zone to be implemented, and to provide this information to the Board for further discussion.
