

Minutes of Meeting
Grail Restaurant Alcoholic Beverage License Revocation
Public Hearing
February 11, 2015
2:00 p.m.

Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman David Stewart and Commissioner Dan Green met to discuss the following agenda items. Also present were Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney R. David Ferguson, Recording Manager Yuen Allison, Records Technician Ashleigh Suggs, and Deputy Clerk Mary Enquist. Commissioner Marc Eberlein was excused.

A. Call to Order: Chairman Stewart called the meeting to order at 2:03 p.m.

B. Introductions: There were no introductions made.

C. Changes to the Agenda: There were no changes to the agenda.

D. Old Business: There was no old business discussed.

E. New Business:

The Board met to conduct a Public Hearing, for which notice was given in the *Coeur d'Alene Press* on January 27, 2015 and February 3, 2015, pursuant to *Idaho code §23-933B*, and *Kootenai County Ordinance 3-1-10*. The hearing addressed possible violations of Idaho law and Kootenai County ordinance concerning the Grail's alcoholic beverage license.

Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney R. David Ferguson said that he spoke with the Grail's counsel Susan Weeks who said there was no need for a public hearing since Grail owners Mr. and Mrs. Sumner are willing to surrender the alcoholic beverage license.

Commissioner Green moved to accept the voluntary surrendering of the alcoholic beverage license from the Grail Restaurant and therefore there is no need to have a public hearing. Chairman Stewart seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Deputy Clerk Enquist called the roll:

The motion carried.
