

**Minutes of Meeting**  
**Coeur d'Alene Restoration Update**  
**April 23, 2015**  
**1:30 p.m.**

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman David Stewart, Commissioner Dan Green and Commissioner Marc Eberlein met to discuss the following agenda items. Also present were Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) Regional Administrator Dan Redline and Biologist Kajsa Vanderiet, Department of Fish and Game Regional Supervisor Chip Corsi and David Leptick, and Deputy Clerk Meshell Missler.

- A. Call to Order:** Chairman David Stewart called the meeting to order at 1:32 p.m.
- B. Introductions:** All the attendees introduced themselves.
- C. Changes to the Agenda:** There were no changes to the agenda.
- D. Old Business:** There was no old business discussed.
- E. New Business:**

Department of Fish and Game Regional Supervisor Chip Corsi gave the Board a draft Restoration Plan Summary used by the Coeur d'Alene Basin Natural Resource Trustees. Mr. Corsi said the Trustees are:

  - U. S. Department of Interior: Fish and Wildlife Service and Bureau of Land Management
  - State of Idaho: Idaho Department of Fish and Game and Idaho Department of Environmental Quality
  - Coeur d'Alene Tribe: Lake Management Department
  - United States Department of Agriculture: Forest Service

Mr. Corsi said all restoration funded by the Trustees must be related to injured natural resources and fulfill the goals and objectives of the restoration plan. He clarified that the United States Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) does the cleanup work, that Federal funds can only be spent on damaged natural resources, and Trustees' are looking at restoration locations which promote economic improvement and have the most benefit to the public.
