

Minutes of Meeting
Gifted View Dr. Drainage Discussion

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman David Stewart, Commissioner Dan Green, and Commissioner Marc Eberlein met to discuss the following agenda items. Also present were Community Development Director David Callahan and Deputy Clerk Theresa Atchley. Also present were citizens Robert and Carrie Braasch.

- A. Call to Order:** Chairman David Stewart called the meeting to order at 10:03 a.m.

Community Development Director David Callahan provided the Board with an overview of the drainage issues at a home on Gifted View Drive. Commissioner Eberlein sympathized with the homeowners, but stated that the County might not have jurisdiction regarding this issue and that Idaho is a due diligence state. Commissioner Green suggested that this is perhaps a civil issue and warned that the Board is responsible for protecting the County from liability. Chairman Stewart stated that this responsibility most likely belongs with other entities.

Chairman Stewart and Director Callahan will coordinate with Eastside Highway District to view the property in an unofficial, information gathering capacity to provide drainage suggestions to the homeowners.
