

Minutes of Meeting

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman David Stewart and Commissioner Dan Green met to discuss the following agenda items. Real Life Ministries – AIN 137500

Chief Deputy Assessor Richard Houser explained that Civil Deputy Prosecuting Attorney R. David Ferguson had reviewed Real Life Ministries' application for tax exempt status and felt the property met the required elements for tax exempt status. Commissioner Dan Green said there was a change in ownership and therefore it was necessary to re-apply for tax exempt status. Commissioner Green read Mr. Ferguson's recommendation and agreed that Real Life Ministries qualified under *Idaho Code §63-602B*.

Commissioner Green moved that the application for Real Life Ministries – AIN 137500 did qualify for the tax exempt status based on *Idaho Code §63-602B for Religious Corporations, LLCs or Societies*.
