

Minutes of Meeting
Shared Parking Proposal
May 27, 2016

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman Dan Green, Commissioner Marc Eberlein, and Commissioner David Stewart met to discuss the following agenda item. Also present was Deputy Clerk Alicia Lynch. Also present were Welch-Comer & Associates President and Principal Engineer Phil Boyd and City of Coeur d’Alene Parks & Recreation Director Bill Greenwood.

- A. Call to Order:** Chairman Dan Green called the meeting to order at 9:30 a.m.

Meeting with Phil Boyd of Welch-Comer & Associates to consider details of the City-County shared parking proposal

Welch-Comer & Associates President and Principal Engineer Phil Boyd and City of Coeur d’Alene Parks & Recreation Director Bill Greenwood discussed with the Board concepts and designs for the City-County shared parking proposal.

The Board discussed the use of parking passes and parking validation at length.

Chairman Green inquired if the County converted current parking spaces into disabled parking would there be more standard parking places available in the new lot. Mr. Boyd said he would research the possibility.

The Board decided against the pedestrian overpass.

Mr. Boyd explained that the proposed changes would be presented to the City and he would return to the County with a cost estimate.

Chairman Green asked Mr. Greenwood if it would benefit the City of Coeur d’Alene to have a Commissioner at a City planning meeting. Mr. Greenwood encouraged the Commissioners to participate. The Board agreed that if available a Commissioner would attend a City planning meeting.

The Board asked Mr. Greenwood and Mr. Boyd to discuss improvements to the County’s current parking lots with Buildings & Grounds Director Shawn Riley.
