

Minutes of Meeting
Commissioners' Debriefing Continued
June 1, 2016
3:30 p.m.

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman Dan Green, Commissioner Marc Eberlein, and Commissioner David Stewart met to discuss the following agenda item. Also present were BOCC Administrative Supervisor Nancy Jones, and Deputy Clerks Alicia Lynch and Randi Davis.

- A. **Call to Order:** Chairman Dan Green continued the May 31, 2016, Commissioners' Debriefing at 3:30 p.m. on June 1, 2016.
- B. **Introductions:** There were no introductions.
- C. **Changes to the Agenda:** There were no changes to the agenda.
- D. **Business:**

July 4th Parking Agreement

Chairman Green resumed the discussion of the July 4th Parking Agreement between the County and the Coeur d'Alene Chamber of Commerce. The Board reviewed a map of the Administrative Campus' parking lots and discussed which lots would be available to the Chamber of Commerce. Chairman Green informed Commissioner David Stewart that the discussion had been continued due to a difference of opinion between Commissioner Marc Eberlein and himself.

Chairman Green restated Buildings & Grounds Director Shawn Riley's request that post-celebration trash collection be included in the agreement. BOCC Administrative Supervisor Nancy Jones verified that KCSO would not be using the Administrative parking lot as a mobile command center this year.

Chairman Green recommended attaching a map to the agreement that detailed the lots available to ensure Diamond Parking Services did not overstep their bounds. Commissioner Stewart suggested inviting Coeur d'Alene Chamber of Commerce President Steve Wilson to the meeting when this agreement was approved.

Chairman Green and Commissioner Stewart agreed to offer the parking lots on Garden Avenue, the gravel lot south of the Justice Building, and the lot north of the Administrative Annex Building. Commissioner Marc Eberlein restated his reluctance to grant so much access to the Chamber of Commerce due to complaints from citizens.

The Board directed Ms. Jones to attach the map to the revised agreement. Ms. Jones said that she would add language to the agreement requesting the Chamber of Commerce provide copies of the map to the Diamond Parking Services as well.

- E. Public Comment:** This section is reserved for citizens wishing to address the Board regarding a County related issue. Idaho Law prohibits Board action on items brought under this section except in an emergency circumstance. Comments related to future public hearings should be held for that public hearing. There were no public comments.

Chairman Green adjourned the meeting at 3:42 p.m.
