

Minutes of Meeting
School District Trustee Interview
July 15, 2016
11:00 a.m.

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman Dan Green, Commissioner Marc Eberlein, and Commissioner David Stewart met to discuss the following agenda item. Also present was BOCC Administrative Supervisor Nancy Jones and Deputy Clerk Randi Davis. Also present was citizen Mark Keogh.

- A. Call to Order:** Chairman Dan Green called the meeting to order at 11:10 a.m.
- B. Changes to the Agenda:** There were no changes to the agenda.

Interview with Kootenai School District #274 Board Member Applicant Mark Keogh

Chairman Green opened the meeting stating that since the Kootenai School District had not chosen a new board member to fill a current vacant position, the Commissioners now had the responsibility. He asked citizen Mark Keogh to tell the Board a little about himself and whether he lived in the zone he would be representing. Mr. Keogh said he lived outside of the zone he would represent, and desired the position to promote awareness about implementing better school policies concerning impact testing for head concussions.

Chairman Green asked whether Mr. Keogh was aware that he would have to run for re-election in his zone. Mr. Keogh confirmed he knew it was a one year term. Chairman Green inquired whether he had children attending school in District #274, and he replied that five of his children do. Chairman Green asked Mr. Keogh whether he had any time constraints that would prevent him from being able to attend the District's board meetings. Mr. Keogh responded that he was currently working a rotating shift and would not have problems attending board meetings unless he were working a swing shift. Mr. Keogh confirmed his employer said they would do everything possible to allow him to attend meetings.

Commissioner Marc Eberlein moved to appoint Mark Keogh to the Kootenai County School District #274 Board as pursuant to Idaho Code 33-504. Commissioner David Stewart seconded the motion. There being no further discussion, Deputy Clerk Davis called the roll:

The motion carried.
