

**Minutes of Meeting
Juvenile Probation Update
November 10, 2016

The Kootenai County Board of Commissioners: Chairman Dan Green, Commissioner Marc Eberlein, and Commissioner David Stewart met to discuss the following agenda item. Also present were Juvenile Probation Director Debbie Nadeau and Deputy Clerk Randi Davis.

- A. Call to Order:** Chairman Dan Green called the meeting to order at 1:00 p.m.

County Annual Juvenile Justice Report

Juvenile Probation Director Debbie Nadeau presented the County Annual Juvenile Justice Report to the Idaho Department of Juvenile Corrections reporting from October 1, 2015, to September 30, 2016. Ms. Nadeau said the report showed that the County's recidivism rate was 26%, and 89% of inmates completed the probation program.

Chairman Green asked how many probation officers Juvenile Probation currently employed, and Ms. Nadeau confirmed there were 14, including herself. Commissioner Marc Eberlein asked whether Juvenile Probation tracked its clients as they grew older, and Ms. Nadeau confirmed it did not. Commissioner David Stewart asked what an unsuccessful juvenile discharge was. Ms. Nadeau confirmed an unsuccessful discharge was considered the 11% of inmates that did not complete the probation program. Chairman Green thanked Ms. Nadeau for her work in Juvenile Probation.

- E. Public Comment:** This section is reserved for citizens wishing to address the Board regarding a County related issue. Idaho Law prohibits Board action on items brought under this section except in an emergency circumstance. Comments related to future public hearings should be held for that public hearing. There were no public comments.
